# From Pastor **Tom Lacey**

## *The Amber Tree*

**On Memorial Day Sunday, May 29, we will remember Amber Sue Wilson, Loretta Wilson's daughter, Jacob's sister, and Kristina Lance's niece.**

On Sunday, May 31, 2009, Amber and her best friend, Kaitlin, died in a tragic accident by carbon monoxide poisoning in Amber's house. Amber's memorial service was held at our church. Loretta is a member of our church. Many of us have lots of fond memories of Amber in Sunday school and at youth group nights. She is remembered as a smiling, happy, fun, kind, smart, active, and wonderful girl, daughter, sister, and niece. There are many children and parents who miss Amber today.

In Amber's memory, our Sunday, May 29th worship service will feature a special musician or two. After church, we will bless in her memory a newly planted Hong Kong Orchid tree and plaque placed at its base.

The Hong Kong Orchid tree is a beautiful, colorful, scented tree that grows to about twenty-five feet. From a distance when blooming the tree is a mass of color. Up close, the flowers resemble orchids or butterflies, and they range in color from yellow through pink to deep purple. Our tree will be pink. With its unusual foliage and attention grabbing flowers, the Amber tree will be the highlight of our front yard. I believe it will be a wonderful symbol of sweet Amber's life.

I hope you make a special effort to attend this memorable Sunday service of worship, and the blessing afterward.

## Hardcore Faith

Even if Easter has come and gone, we still need to keep the faith. So important is faith, or should I say, belief, that John's whole gospel is built on it. You need to have belief in order to be Christian. In order to have belief, God needs to give you grace to believe. Pray to God for this grace. ### THE NEED TO GROW

A Peruvian friend in Denver, who helped us start a Hispanic church back in the early 1980s, once said something I'll never forget. *"I've always had the need to grow spiritually,"* he said calmly. I liked that. It summed up everything wise and spiritual... the NEED to grow.

It expresses deep feelings, an open mind, and earnest commitment. It speaks of a mounting love for God, along with friendship and communion with others. It voices a hunger for spiritual qualities and realities, and it senses an inward spiritual lack that needs to be nurtured – with hope!

Spirituality is action and not just knowledge. But it must have knowledge too. That is why we have scriptures, creeds, sermons, liturgy, lyrics and Christian education on all levels. The Jews marveled at Jesus' learning believing he had never studied. But Jesus and all spiritual people have always studied. They have always had the need to grow spiritually.

Summer is coming! You've probably noticed the weather heating up!

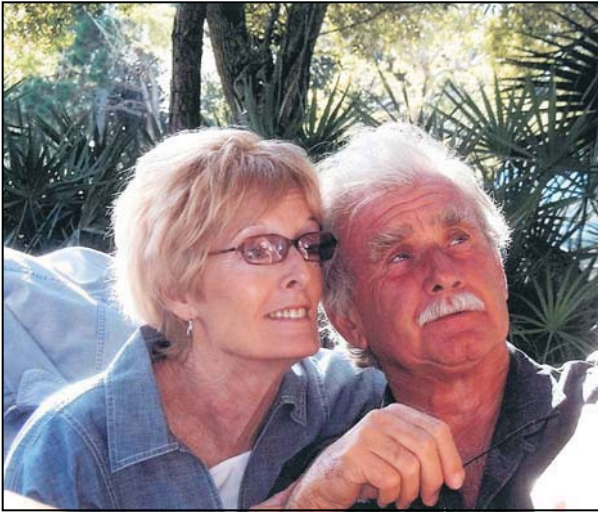
